

Questions for Pastor...

What does Scientology teach?

The question above came from Violet during our vacation last month. While we were in California we took a tour of Hollywood. We got to see where some of the celebrities live. While speeding past John Travola's mansion our tour guide told us that Mr. Travolta is a Scientologist. He then went on to tell us that Scientology is the trendy "religion" in Hollywood. As evidence of that, our guide told us that roughly 25% of the movies coming from Hollywood are produced by people who are "into" Scientology.

As I did some research to find details about specific beliefs on Scientology, I remembered how many times I've fielded questions about what other groups believe, groups like the Jehovah's Witnesses, the Mormons, Muslims, Jews, Unitarians, etc...

There was a time not that long ago (40 years maybe) when the vast majority of people in our country were Christians. But today we are increasingly exposed to people who don't believe what we do. God has told us that we should not be surprised about the increase of "false teachings." He has also told us that we who know the truth need to share it with those who don't ("The Gospel truth" didn't get to be a cliché by accident). But before we can share Jesus with people of other beliefs, it is helpful to know the basics of their beliefs.

With that in mind, I decided now would be a good time to take a look at the beliefs of some of these groups. So, for six weeks, beginning Sunday, September 10, we will do just that in our 9:15 Adult Forum. (see page 17)

What Do Missouri Synod Lutherans Believe?



A Minute for Parents...

A lesson from our Heavenly Father about passing along your faith...

When it comes to passing along your faith to your children, our heavenly Father hasn't left us in the dark. He gave us specific instructions in Deuteronomy 11:

"Teach [my words] to your children, talking about them when you sit at home and when you walk along the road, when you lie down and when you get up."

i.e. Talk about God in all situations, all day, every day. Here are some suggestions:


- Pray with your children as often as you can. Before school, before meals, before bed. When they are afraid. When they are facing a decision. When they are hurt. If they don't live at home, you can pray with them on the phone - really!
- Have a family devotion with your children daily. This
 is also a great way to "force" you to talk about your faith
 in Jesus.
- Talk about the worship service on the way home from church. Ask questions about favorite songs, the sermon, Sunday School lessons, etc... Talk about ways you can each put what you heard into practice this week.
- Talk about God in the everyday aspects of life. For example, instead of "Isn't that a beautiful sunset," try "God sure gave us a beautiful sunset today." Or maybe, instead of "I sure got lucky on the road today..." try "God sure had his angels working overtime protecting me in traffic today."
- Set rules for your children based on God's
 instructions and commands. Explain to your children
 that these rules are not just your idea, but the way God
 wants us to live. Explain that He gives us rules because
 he loves us and knows what is harmful for us and he
 doesn't want to see us harmed

It will be important to remind your children that we obey God's rules not to "earn our way into heaven." Remind page 8 page 9

them that because of our sin, we can never earn our way into heaven. Rather, teach them that we obey God's rules more as a way to say, "Thank you, God" for purchasing heaven for us (what Jesus did on the cross) and offering it to us as a gift (which we receive when we play our faith in Jesus).

And don't forget to ask your heavenly father's help.

He has all the power you need!
