

Question for Pastor...

What makes you so sure that Jesus rose from the dead?

That's a great question, because the fact of the Resurrection is the "hinge-pin" that our fath hangs on. If Jesus didn't rise from the grave, the "doors fall off" so to speak. Christianity falls apart. The apostle Paul said as much in 1 Corinthians 15:14-19



And if Christ has not been raised, our preaching is useless and so is your faith. 15 More than that, we are then found to be false witnesses about God, for we have testified about God that he raised Christ from the dead. But he did not raise him if in fact the dead are not raised. 16 For if the dead are not raised, then Christ has not been raised either. 17 And if Christ has not been raised, your faith is futile; you are still in your sins. 18 Then those also who have fallen asleep in Christ are lost. 19 If only for this life we have hope in Christ, we are of all people most to be pitied.

If the last word on Jesus is His death on the cross, then He is no different from anyone else who claimed to be sent by God to be "the final word on the subject" of how to get to God. (And there have been lots of people throughout the ages who have claimed just that.)

However, if Jesus has indeed risen from the dead, then He can be trusted as being the only One who was really telling the truth about being God's "Final Word." Jesus' resurrection from the grave would serve to validate as true everything He said. (Think about it... do you suppose God would have raised Him from the grave if He'd been lying to us?!) Jesus' resurrection from the grave is the basis for our hope that death will not be the end for us either.

Jesus' Resurrection really matters that much! So, here's a sampling of the main reasons....

Why We Believe Jesus Rose from the Dead:

- Jesus predicted His resurrection (Matt 16:21; Mark 9:9-10; John 2:18-22). so that when it happened everyone would know it wasn't a "fluke."
- The Old Testament prophesied it (Psalm 16:10;compare Acts 2:25-31; 13:33-37).
- The tomb was empty and the grave clothes vacant. If those
 who opposed Christ wished to silence His disciples, all they had
 to do was produce a body, but they could not. (John 20:3-9).
- Many people saw the resurrected Christ. They looked on His face, touched Him, heard His voice, and saw Him eat (Matt. 28:16-20; Luke 24:13-39; John 20:11-29; John 21:1-9; Acts 1:6-11; 1 Cor. 15:3-8).
- The lives of the disciples were radically changed. Though they fled and even denied Christ at the time of His arrest, they later feared no one in their proclamation of the risen Christ (Matt 26:56, 69-75). People are not willing to die for a lie.
- The resurrection was the central message of the early church. The church grew with an unwavering conviction that Christ had physically risen from the dead and was the Lord of the church (Acts 4:33; 5:30-32; Rom. 5:24).
- Men and women today testify that the power of the risen Christ has transformed their lives. We know that Jesus is alive not only because of the historical and biblical evidence but also because He has miraculously touched and changed OUR lives.

As the Apostle Paul continues in 1 Corinthians 15:

20 But Christ has indeed been raised from the dead, the firstfruits of those who have fallen asleep. 21 For since death came through a man, the resurrection of the dead comes also through a man. 22 For as in Adam all die, so in Christ all will be made alive. 23 But each in turn: Christ, the firstfruits; then, when he comes, those who belong to him....When the perishable has been clothed with the imperishable, and the mortal with immortality, then the saying that is written will come true: "Death has been swallowed up in victory."

55 "Where, O death, is your victory? Where, O death, is your sting?"

56 The sting of death is sin, and the power of sin is the law. 57 But thanks be to God! He gives us the victory through our Lord Jesus Christ.

58 Therefore, my dear brothers and sisters, stand firm. Let nothing move you. Always give yourselves fully to the work of the Lord, because you know that your labor in the Lord is not in vain.



Dear Family and Friends,

On Sunday, May 5th in Hutchinson, I will join thousands of others in a movement to end multiple sderosis by participating in Walk MS 2013. When you make a gift to the National MS Society, you support research and local services to those affected with this unpredictable disease.

I have a personal stake in this particular event. I was diagnosed with MS in December 2009. I started a team in 2010 of Friends and Family members called Mama's Movers and Shakers (Mama's MS). I take Rebif which is a disease modifying drug which it reduces frequency of relapses in people who have multiple sclerosis (MS). It also delays some of the physical disabilities caused by MS.I have been giving myself a shot 3 times a week since January 18th, 2010. With MRI's we have seen some of the lesions in my brain and spinal cord reduce their size. Not only do I want to help myself and my support group, but also the other people diagnosed with MS who live in the Upper Midwest Chapter area, MS is a disease that affects the central nervous system. Some symptoms of MS may include loss of balance, impaired vision and hearing, fatigue, musde weakness and, in some, paralysis. Even simple everyday living skills become increasingly difficult. Everyone is affected differently by these symptoms.

Once I got back to Thailand, I jumped straight into the Xealot leadership program. We began by attending an urban missions summit with Shane Claiborne. We then headed up to Mae Sot, a small city on the Thai-Burmese border, to work with Burmese refugees.

We were in Mae Sot for four days, and were able to visit two orphanages and a refugee community that actually lived in a garbage dump. These refugees are all part of the Karen ethnic group, a minority that is severely persecuted by the Burmese junta. Many of the kids from the orphanages had just wandered out of the jungle, with no idea where their parents are.

Since being back in Bangkok, I have also been able to bring kids in the Safe House gifts from America! Children from an inner city school in Washington DC wanted to help the kids in the Safe House, so they bought a bunch of toys and school supplies for them.

While I was in America, I visited this school, and brought back their gifts to Thailand. When I gave our kids their presents, they were ecstatic! The kids went



wild over their new treasures and felt so good to know that kids in America cared about them.

Story Behind The Song...

O Glorious Day

The song "Glorious Day (Living He Loved Me)" was made famous by the contemporary Christian band Casting Crowns. The lyrics came from the John Wilbur Chapman hymn 'One Day When Heaven Was Filled With His Praises or more often called 'One Day which was written in 1909. The credits for the modern version of the song are Words by J. Wilbur Chapman (1909), Music by Michael Bleecker @ 2008 Word Music.

Easter was approaching, and I was having a difficult time finding good Easter songs to sing. As a worship pastor, that can be very disheartening. So I did what any God-fearing worship pastor would do: I Goggled "Easter Worship Songs." I browsed around trying to find the right song when my eye caught the word "Hymnal."

I walked over to my stack of hymnals and pulled out the 1939 copy of "The Hymns of Praise - Numbers One and Two Combined" from a church in Kenosha, Wisconsin (I don't know how it got to my bookshelf). I flipped through the yellowed pages and found "One Day." As I carefully pulled back page 172, I read:

Living, He loved me; dying He saved me; Buried, He carried my sins far away; Rising, He justified freely forever; One day He's coming - oh glorious day!

That's the gospel in four creatively written lines. The verses of the song expound each line of the chorus: verse one describes the birth of Christ, verse two the death of Christ, verse three the ascension of Christ and verse four the return of Christ.

I'm grateful for the Presbyterian evangelist Rev. John Wilbur Chapman and his hymn from the late 1800s. From combining his words with a melody the Lord gave me in five minutes, came "Glorious Day." I pray that it be used to teach the gospel and stir the affections of others for Jesus Christ.


