

Lessons from Bible Guys: Thomas

What usually comes to mind when you hear about Thomas is that infamous statement he made after hearing the other disciples tell him that Jesus was risen from the dead: "Unless I see the nail marks in his hands and put my finger where the nails were, and put my hand into his side, I will not believe it."

But the example I want to focus on today is a question Thomas asked the night *before* Jesus was crucified. Jesus had just told His disciples that He was going away to prepare a place for them in His Father's house, and that He would come back to take them there. Then he said, "You know the way to the place where I am going."

At that point I can envision all the disciples scratching their heads and whispering to each other, wondering just what Jesus is talking about. But no one wants to let on that they don't have a clue - except Thomas. Thomas asks the question that was likely on everyone's mind:

"Lord, we don't know where you are going, so how can we know the way?"

It doesn't matter how long you've known Jesus (Thomas was with Him on a daily basis for three whole years), there are still going to be things that you don't understand. That's to be expected. He's God and we aren't. It's natural that we don't always "get it." But Thomas sets us the example of what to do when we don't "get it." He asks a question.

Here's the great answer that Thomas' question led to:

"I am the way, the truth and the life. No one comes to the Father but by me."


